

Champion Lakes Golf and Country Club

There are very few activities we can do during this pandemic. Golf happens to be one that is safe and manageable if we make the necessary adjustments and adhere to the guidelines of social distancing.

We ask you to please read and be prepared to diligently follow the rules so we can enjoy golfing this season. The Provincial Government needs to see that golf courses can follow protocol and allow us to stay open and safe.

ANY BREACH OF THESE RULES WILL MEAN AN IMMEDIATE LOSS OF PLAYING PRIVILEGES

1. Opening day is planned for May 1st. This gives our staff time to get the course ready and put all protocols in place. Do not ask or come out to golf before this date.
2. Tee time **MUST BE BOOKED**. No drop in's will be permitted. If you do not have a tee time you will be turned away. All golfer's names must be registered when booking.
3. Members in good standing will have first right or refusal for tee time's until 12pm daily. Public may fill any tee times after 12pm or any tee times not booked by members before 12pm.
4. Arrival at the course is limited to 10 minutes before your pre-booked tee time. No lingering around before or after your round.
5. One person per cart will be permitted. Push carts will be available. Each cart will be sanitized and disinfected before and after each round. The only exception to this rule is people residing in the same household. Proof must be provided. Carts must be booked in advance. 2 Carts per group is permitted.
6. For members with lockers, please ensure social distancing or consider taking your clubs home.
7. **DO NOT** touch the flags. Cups will be raised.
8. Do not share clubs, balls, or any other equipment with other golfers.
9. Pro Shop will allow 2 people in at a time with a sanitizing station setup at entry.
10. Ball washers and benches will be removed and the bathroom between #3 and #4 & #8 will be out of service.
11. Obey all signage regarding social distancing and sanitizing as it pertains to the COVID-19 protocols.
12. The driving range will be open but limited to 5 users at a time. Balls will be sanitized and provided by the Pro Shop. No self serve will be permitted.
13. The restaurant, patio, and practice green will be closed.
14. Cash payments will be permitted; However, credit or debit is preferred.
15. Tee times will be spaced out substantially, no playing through will be permitted.

The above is subject to change if mandated by the Provincial/Federal Government
